PINE CREEK TOWNSHIP SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES OF AUGUST 16, 2023

The Pine Creek Township Board of Supervisors held a special meeting on August 16, 2023, at 7:00 p.m., with Supervisors John M. Reese and Dean L. Edwards, Jr. present.

Solicitor Thom Rosamilia explained the reason for the Special Meeting is for the Supervisors to select a successor for the supervisor position recently vacated by Ken Packard.

Pursuant to Section 407 of the Second Class Township Code the two remaining Supervisors may select a successor to the supervisor position. That supervisor would serve until the end of this calendar year.

Solicitor Rosamilia stated that there were three candidates that expressed interest in the position and requested Chairman Edwards to list the three candidates and indicated there would be a public comment period that would relate only to the candidates for this position. If the Supervisors agree on a candidate, they will then by motion appoint someone to the vacant position; if the Supervisors are not in agreement as to the appointment and do not fill the position within 30 days, it will then go before the Vacancy Board.

Chairman listed the following individuals who submitted letters of interest for the supervisor position: John Krupa, Dustin Counsil and Dave Winkleman, Jr.

Public Comment

Resident Rhonda Davis Sweeney questioned whether John Krupa was a good candidate for the Supervisor position and noted the condition of his establishment, Johnny K's, stating from the outside of that building, it looks like it could be condemned, and asked if this was someone that would be a good representative of the township.

Vacant Supervisor Position

Supervisor Reese made a motion to appoint Dave Winkleman, Jr. to the vacant supervisor position; seconded by Chairman Edwards, MCU.

Adjournment

There being no further business, Chairman Edwards adjourned the meeting at 7:05 pm.
