

PINE CREEK TOWNSHIP SPECIAL MEETING  
MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 14, 2023

The Pine Creek Township Board of Supervisors held a special meeting on November 14, 2023, at 7:00 p.m., with Supervisors John M. Reese and Dave Winkleman, Jr. present.

Also present: Kevin Ferrar, Michele Whitney, Bryan Poorman and Taryn Saar

Supervisor Reese requested that individuals video recording the meeting identify themselves. Those recording were Kevin Ferrara on behalf of himself, and Michele Whitney of the Clinton County Watchdogs.

Supervisor Reese made a motion to amend the meeting agenda to add the Recreation Committee; seconded by Supervisor Winkleman, MC.

**2024 Budget**

Supervisor Winkleman noted that copies of the preliminary 2024 Budget were available for the public to look at during the meeting.

Supervisors Winkleman said the projected revenues for 2024 are \$1.324 million dollars and currently the budgeted expenditures are \$1.33 million.

Supervisor Winkleman made a motion to approve the preliminary 2024 Budget; seconded by Supervisor Reese, MC.

**Recreation Committee**

Taryn Saar of the Recreation Committee spoke to the Supervisors about the Committee's plan to have "Woolrich Wonderland" at the Woolrich Park and requested the Supervisors approve releasing up to \$1,000.00 to the Recreation Committee for materials and supplies for the event. She said the Committee may not have to use the entire amount as they are asking for sponsorships and donations.

Supervisor Winkleman made a motion to release up to \$1,000.00 to the Recreation Committee to be utilized as needed for the Woolrich Wonderland event; seconded by Supervisor Reese, MC.
